Located in Eddington, Maine, Camp Roosevelt is owned by the Katahdin Scout Reservation, Boy Scouts of America. Camp has recently had major renovations that include a new kitchen and dining hall. The facility provides an excellent place for meetings. Camp Roosevelt is located next to Fitts Pond. Waterfront will be open when a lifeguard is present. Fitts Pond is open for fishing with Maine fishing license. Boat launch open for kayaks, canoes, and boats with motors less than 10 HP allowed. Some rental services are available.

Directions

From Interstate 95: Take 395 to Brewer. Exit at end of bridge, continue East (right) on South Main St. until it becomes to Rt. 9
From Brewer: Rt. 9 East, turn right onto Rt. 46 – go ¼ mile & turn left onto Blackcap Road & follow signs.
From Ellsworth: Rt. 1, take a right onto Rt. 46 – go 5 miles & turn right onto Blackcap Road and follow signs.
From Calais: Rt. 9, left onto Rt. 46, go ¼ mile & turn left onto Blackcap Road & follow signs
